33 students carried out the survey "Changes in cities".

Half of them did the survey in town Będzin asking random people in the street, the community centre, shops, the railway and bus station. They were people of all ages of different social status.

The other group did the survey in their families asking relatives or neighbours about their place of living.

Age

- 12 people were 40-60 years old
- 8 people were 25-40 years old
- 6 people were 18 -25 years old
- 7 retired over 60 years old

Employment

- 70% were employed
- 21% were retired
- 9% were students (some of them employed)




Marital status

• 79% lived in a couple



Changed the place of living

- 21% moved from a smaller to a bigger town
- 31% moved from a town to the countryside



- The most common reason to change the place of living was personal reasons 52%.
- Next was financial reasons.
- Only 2 people said they moved house because of professional reasons.



Place of living

• 48% claimed they live in the block of flats, others live in detached houses.



- 14 people live in the suburbs(42%)
- 8 people live in the town centre (24%)
- 11 people live in the housing estate (34%)



As the means of transport people indicate

- 78% the car
- 36% public transport (bus, train, tram)
- 3% bike or motorbike

Relationship with neighbours

• 94% of surveyed people described their relationship with neighbours as friendly and kind.





Opinion about the place of living

- 85% people refer to their place of living as comfortable.
- The rest 15% who claimed their place living is uncomfortable live in the suburbs or housing estates.
