

CHANGES IN OUR CITIES – SPANISH SURVEY REPORT

We have worked on the analysis of changes in cities, based on the professional situation of the people asked, 120 people answered to our form. In this part of the population we have asked on the survey, there were 64 female and 56 male. The age average is between 25 and 40 years, being most of them employed, followed by students and unemployed people. Most of them are in a couple with children.

Most of them have changed their place of living, for various reasons, being the professional the 49%, followed by personal reasons with a 41%, and financial the 10%.

Changing from a town to a big city is the most common answer with a 41%, followed nearly by the ones that have changed from the countryside to a big city. People don't tend to move to the countryside.

At least, people lived in their original place around 10 to 25 years, living here from 5 to 30 years. Like is supposed, people that have never changed their place of living, have been living here for their whole life.

In Puertollano, the population that lives in a flat is predominant over the people that live in a house with a difference of a 13%, or share one of this two. Related to the accommodation, most of them have chosen the city/town center for their place of living. The housing state is the less common here with a 12% only.

Talking about the relationship with the neighbors many people had agreed on that their relationship is polite or friendly, although for some of them it's inexistent or hostile, only a 4%. Amorous relationships are kind of common between them, as well.

The car is the favorite method of transport for a 57%, not forgetting about the public transport, which is also very important for 32% of the population. Two-wheeled vehicles aren't very used, only by an 8%, and some people take other methods, like going on foot.

About the feeling of living in a town or city, the 57% thinks that it's just comfortable, over the 33% that thinks is very comfortable. The feeling of being uncomfortable is not very shared between the population.

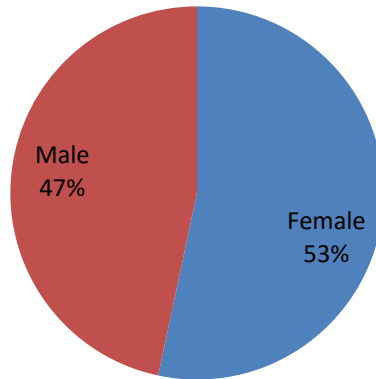
The city/town living is prefer instead of the countryside living, by a little difference of a 14%. The reasons are almost the same for explaining why they prefer each type of living:

People that prefers the city/town living is because they think that this type of living is comfortable, you have many things to do, places to go, shops...

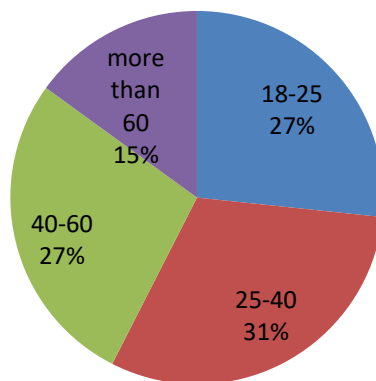

In conclusion, most of the population is employed, in a couple with children. Most of them have changed the place of living, mainly from a town to a big city for professional reasons. Most of them live in a flat located in the city/town center, and the main transport that is used is the car. The relationship with their neighbors is good in the majority of the cases. And if we make them choose where to live, they choose living in a town/city, because it's comfortable for them.

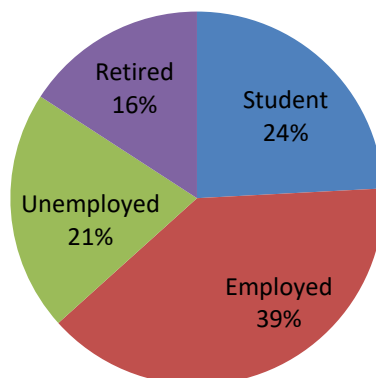

2.- Age

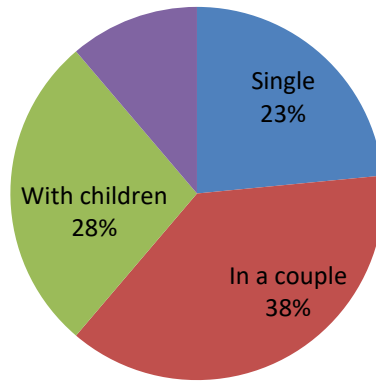


3.- What you are

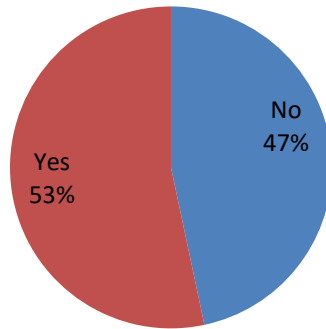

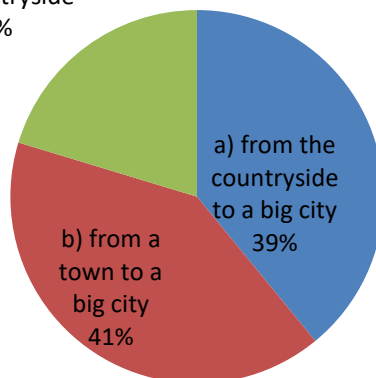

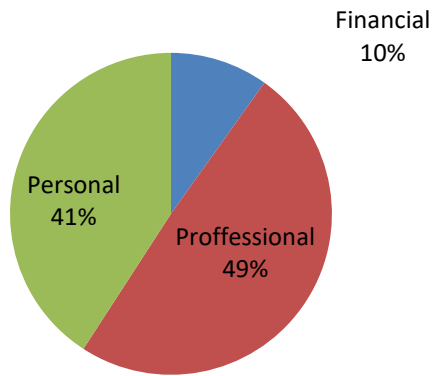

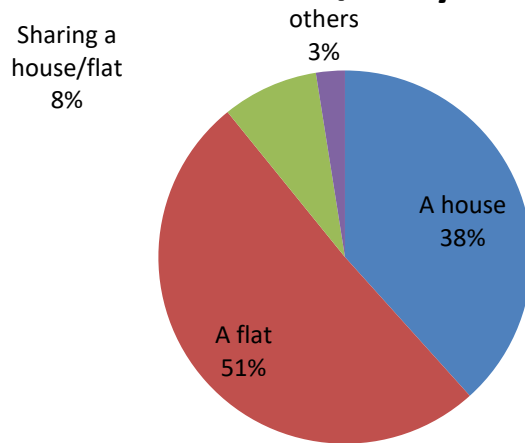

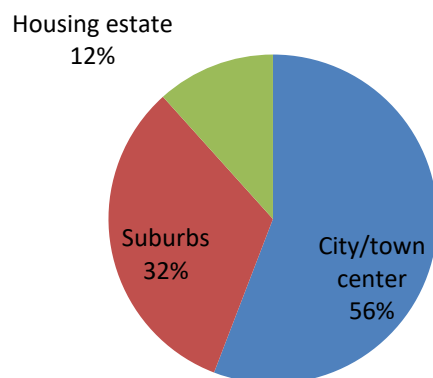

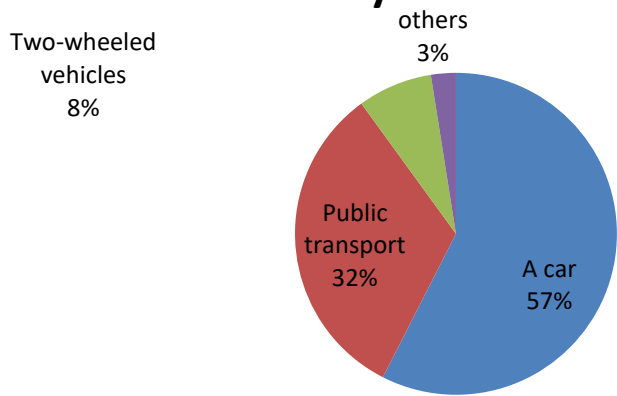

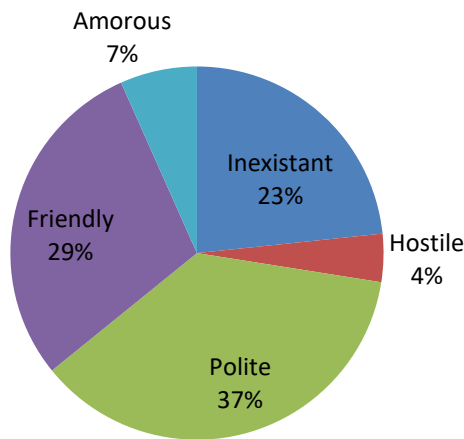

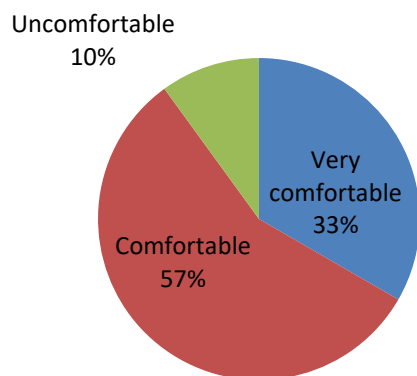
